Resolution and Court Administration Services is a group of programs and services offered by the Government of Alberta, Justice and Solicitor General in collaboration with the courts of Alberta.

Information Services

Information Services provides:

- Information on court procedures and legal service options
- Assistance with locating court forms
- Referrals to other community legal resources.

Assessment Services

Assessment Services provides:

- Information on options and services for resolving family issues
- Referrals to services and programs, including family mediation
- Information on the effects of separation and divorce on children
- Assistance with court documentation and processes for family law matters
- **Caseflow Conference Program:** Caseflow Conferences are scheduled between a caseflow coordinator and the applicant and respondent to explore settlement options, facilitate settlement and facilitate access to the Court.

Dispute Resolution Services

Child Support Resolution (CSR)- Edmonton Dispute Resolution Officer (DRO) - Calgary provides a consultation with a family lawyer to help people resolve their child support disagreements.
